Transition to bichronous learning during pandemic to maintain flexibility and engagement for faculty


#### **Post-Pandemic Continuation**

Feedback driven decision to maintain the bichronous format

Combination of synchronous and asynchronous components

## **Course Improvement Cohort**



#### **Cohort Meetings**

There are 16 biweekly cohort meetings over two semesters. 1 hr in length via Zoom.



#### **Course Prep**

All course prep is done through online "assignments" where members share their progress



#### Mentorship

There are 16 biweekly mentor meetings over two semesters. 30-1hr in length via zoom.




#### **Internal Review**
