

# Showcase Model

#### PROs

- Provides concrete examples of exemplary practices
- Acknowledges the good work of the course developer



 Provides motivation to create one's own course to standards




### CONs

- The course must first be developed and then reviewed for best practices
- Course developers must spend the time to replicate standards in their own courses

## Template Model



# Establishes a framework into which content is placed



# Template Model



• Provides a standard applied to all courses

 Consistency and time savings as template is pre-designed



#### CONs

- A template design must be developed, agreed upon and adopted by the institution
- The faculty must be persuaded to use the template
- Does not allow for creativity and individual preferences in course development



# **Directory Model**



#### Files, ideas, and resources are shared among users



# **Directory Model**



- Provides examples in best practice that can be adopted and "tweaked"
- Time savings in development as items are shared
- Course developers maintain creativity and preferences in course, emphasizes academic freedom
- Builds a spirit of collaboration and collegiality among users



#### CONs

- Items must be "housed" for borrowing
- Training must be provided to find and copy items
- Faculty must be persuaded to use shared items
